Practice Round – Notice to Competitors

Each player and group must maintain the normal pace of play as specified by The Club at Rolling Hills. Groups that fall behind may be asked by club staff to regain their position on the course. If, after a reasonable time, the group has not regained their position or has fallen back out of place, staff may require the group to move back into position, skipping one or more holes, if necessary.

The required pace of play for the practice round is 15 minutes per hole and 4:30 for the entire round. Please be considerate of all players behind you so they have the opportunity to finish their rounds before dark.

In an effort to maintain the condition of the golf course and pace of play, each player may play only **one ball** during the practice round, except that each player may chip or putt more than one ball from an area within ten (10) yards of any putting green provided the group maintains pace of play per the course guidelines.

As guests of the Thorncreek Golf Club, players must replace divots, smooth bunkers, and repair ball marks on putting greens and closely mown areas of the golf course.
