I. MAJOR CHANGES FROM LAST YEAR'S REPORT:

- a. 1A Girls Regionals will expand to 12 regions (from 8). Each region will only have 2 teams (not 3). The 12 regional winners will advance to state.

II. RATIONALE FOR MAJOR CHANGES:

- a. Allows for more schools to host and avoids rematches at the State Tournament.

III. FINANCIAL IMPACT:

- a. Decreased travel for four (4) 1A schools.

V. INFORMATIONAL ITEMS:

- a. The committee met on November 17, 2023.
- b. All athletic directors are responsible for ensuring that their schedules are up to date and correct in MaxPreps prior to the deadline.

- c. In the event that two teams have the same *CHSAA Selection & Seeding Index ranking* in the final standings, the following tiebreakers shall be used (in order) to determine who makes it into Regionals:
 - i. Head-to-head competition
 - ii. Who has the highest MaxPreps ranking
 - iii. Who has the highest CHSAA RPI ranking
 - iv. Coin flip
- d. It is strongly recommended that coaches be clear on the number of matches their team will play in a given tournament. This information must be included in the tournament contract and all volleyball tournaments must be sanctioned by the CHSAA office.
- e. It is strongly recommended that 2 out of 3 sets be played at all sub-varsity levels to enhance time management constraints. Further recommendations to shorten nights include:
 - i. Scheduling 2, 3 or 4-team round robins on Saturdays when possible to lessen time for weeknight matches.
 - ii. Monitoring warm-up time between matches.
 - iii. Flipping coins before the first sub-varsity match for all matches that will be played that evening/day.
 - iv. Use of multiple nets and/or gymnasiums where available.
- f. Regionals must be played Friday or Saturday. When mutual agreement cannot be reached for the Regionals Volleyball tournament, and travel distance for any team is 150 miles or greater, then the Regional tournament will be played on Saturday.
- g. **CHSAA, CVOA, and host schools will prioritize schools traveling great distances when assigning officials. Best practice to accommodate our limited officials is for leagues to work together to split regional dates between Friday and Saturday.**
- h. It is recommended that site directors & regional tournaments build in a minimum 30-minute rest period for teams having played back-to-back matches prior to a subsequent match. (15-minute break then 15-minutes warm-up).
- i. Line judges will use flags at the State Tournament. Regional site directors should use flags.
- j. The official game ball of the CHSAA is the Wilson K1 Gold – Red/White/Navy color

VI. SPORT POLICY/PROCEDURES:

- a. State Association Adoption of NFHS Playing Rules:
 - 1. 1-2, note 2 Modification of match format is permitted for other than dual varsity matches.
 - 2. 9-1-2 Modification of benches. Teams will not change bench during play unless there is a distinct advantage/disadvantage on one side.
- b. Volleyball Coaches Professionalism – Professional attire and demeanor is expected at all matches, especially at the CHSAA State Volleyball Championships. Coaches are expected to dress professionally and not in athletic gear for the state tournament.

VII. QUALIFYING FORMAT:

REGIONAL TIE BREAKER METHOD (for CHSAA Playoff Competition)

******In the case of a tie, the Tournament Director must call the CHSAA Volleyball Administrator *BEFORE the tie breaker in order to verify*. All involved teams must sign off verifying they are in agreement that the tie was broken accurately using the following method.

Match record determines the seed for advancement (i.e. match record 3-0, 2-1, 1-2).

1. Always use head-to-head whenever two teams are tied.
2. **REGIONALS:** If there is a three-way tie for only one qualifying spot, determine set percentage among TIED teams (eliminate non-tied teams). The two lowest set percentage teams will play one set to 25 points (no cap). The winner will then immediately play the highest set percentage team to determine the top seed/qualifying spot in question. If two teams are tied with the highest set percentage, use head-to-head to break the tie. **THERE MUST BE TWO, ONE-SET PLAYOFFS.**
 - a. If tie isn't broken, then same procedure will be followed taking point differential among TIED teams (eliminate non-tied teams).
 - b. If the tie isn't broken, then the same procedure will be followed taking the set percentage among ALL teams.
 - c. If tie isn't broken, then a **coin flip** will occur. All three teams will flip at the same time. You must flip until one team flips differently than the other two (i.e. 2 heads and 1 tails). The "odd" team out (tails in this case) will be set aside and the other two will play the first set to 25. The loser will be #3; the winner will then play the "odd" team out one set to 25 to determine #1 and #2.

Three-way tie for one state qualifier requires two, one-set playoffs to 25 points

Team 1 (highest set percentage) – Set Aside

Team 2 & Team 3 must play one-set playoffs to 25 points; Team who wins will then play Team 1 (one-set playoff to 25 points) for the state berth

BOYS & GIRLS REGIONALS

1. There will be 12 regionals for all girls classifications. There will be 8 regionals for boys. 1A Girls' Regionals will have two (2) teams – a total of one match will be played (24 total teams). 2A-5A Girls' Regionals and Boys Regionals will have three teams – a total of three matches will be played. Boys will have a total of 24 teams advancing, and 2A-5A girls will have a total of 36 teams advancing. All regional winners will automatically earn a berth to the state championship.
2. The highest seed in each regional will host.
3. The order of regional play (2A-5A girls only) will be as follows: 1 v. 3; 2 v. 3; 1 v. 2.
4. Matches will be 3 out of 5 sets to 25 points, with deciding set to 15 points using rally scoring (no cap) used for regional play. (2A-5A Girls Only) Matches that do not impact the State Qualifier (1st) will be the best 2 out of 3 sets (3rd set to 25 – no cap). **This will only happen if Team 3 beats Team 1 and Team 2 in the first two matches.*
5. There must be a minimum of 30 minutes scheduled in-between matches in order to accommodate for adequate rest (15 minutes) for the team that is playing back to back (2A-5A Girls Only).
6. The 15-minute warm-up is required. It is the responsibility of the home site's management to oversee warm-up time.
 - 5 minutes – Both teams on their side of the court.
 - 5 minutes – Visiting team both sides of the court (including serving).
 - 5 minutes – Home team both sides of the court.
7. (2A-5A Girls Only) The tie-breaker procedure must be utilized. The hot line number must be used whenever there is a tie to verify tie-breaker accuracy for final standings. **Ties during regional play will be limited to 3-teams tied for 1st. There must be two, one-set playoffs to 25 (no cap).*
8. AWARDS – One state qualifier plaque will be awarded to the regional winner advancing to state.
9. OFFICIALS – Officials will be selected by the regional directors/tournament committee. Line judge fees would be part of the tournament expenses.

REGIONAL SEEDING & BRACKETS

With two/three teams in each regional, only one court is necessary. Those schools hosting regionals should have adequate seating capacity. Standards without cables attached to floor should be used for safety reasons.

1. **(GIRLS ONLY – Boys, skip to number 2 below)** All league champions (as long as there is a minimum of 5 teams in a league) will automatically earn a berth to regionals
2. **Girls:** The remaining teams (up to 24: 1A, and up to 36: 2A-5A) will be selected straight off of the *CHSAA Selection & Seeding Index (50% CHSAA RPI & 50% MaxPreps Rankings)* published at the end of the regular season.
Boys: All 24 teams will be selected straight off of the *CHSAA Selection & Seeding Index (50% CHSAA RPI & 50% MaxPreps Rankings)* published at the end of the regular season.
3. **(GIRLS & BOYS)** Teams will also be seeded based off the same *CHSAA Selection & Seeding Index*.
 1. Once on the bracket, teams can be moved one spot at a maximum based upon trying to alleviate league opponent matchups between the top 2 seeds in the region. Host teams will not be moved.
 2. When possible, geography will be considered for the number three seeds of each region. Teams may only be moved a maximum of four spots.
4. Teams seeded No. 1 through 12 (girls) and teams seeded No. 1 through 8 (boys) will host regionals.
5. **(GIRLS & BOYS)** All regional winners will automatically advance to the state championships.

GIRLS & BOYS STATE TOURNAMENT TEAMS

1. **Girls Volleyball:** Twelve (12) regional winners will advance to state.
2. **Boys Volleyball:** Eight (8) regional winners will advance to state.

STATE VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT FORMAT

1. Girls' State Bracket: 12-Team Olympic Crossover bracket.
2. Boys' State Bracket: 8-Team Double Elimination bracket until the semifinals. Single elimination through the semis and finals.
3. Based on the state seeding criteria, 8/12 teams will be seeded into the bracket. The top 4 teams will have a first -round bye. Competition will begin on Thursday.
4. All matches will be three out of five sets to 25 points (no cap) with the deciding set to 15 points (no cap).
5. Court classification will be rotated each year (girls only).
6. A first and second place trophy will be awarded.

STATE SEEDING/PAIRING CRITERIA

The CHSAA Selection & Seeding Index published the Monday *prior to* Regionals will be the only seeding consideration for State.

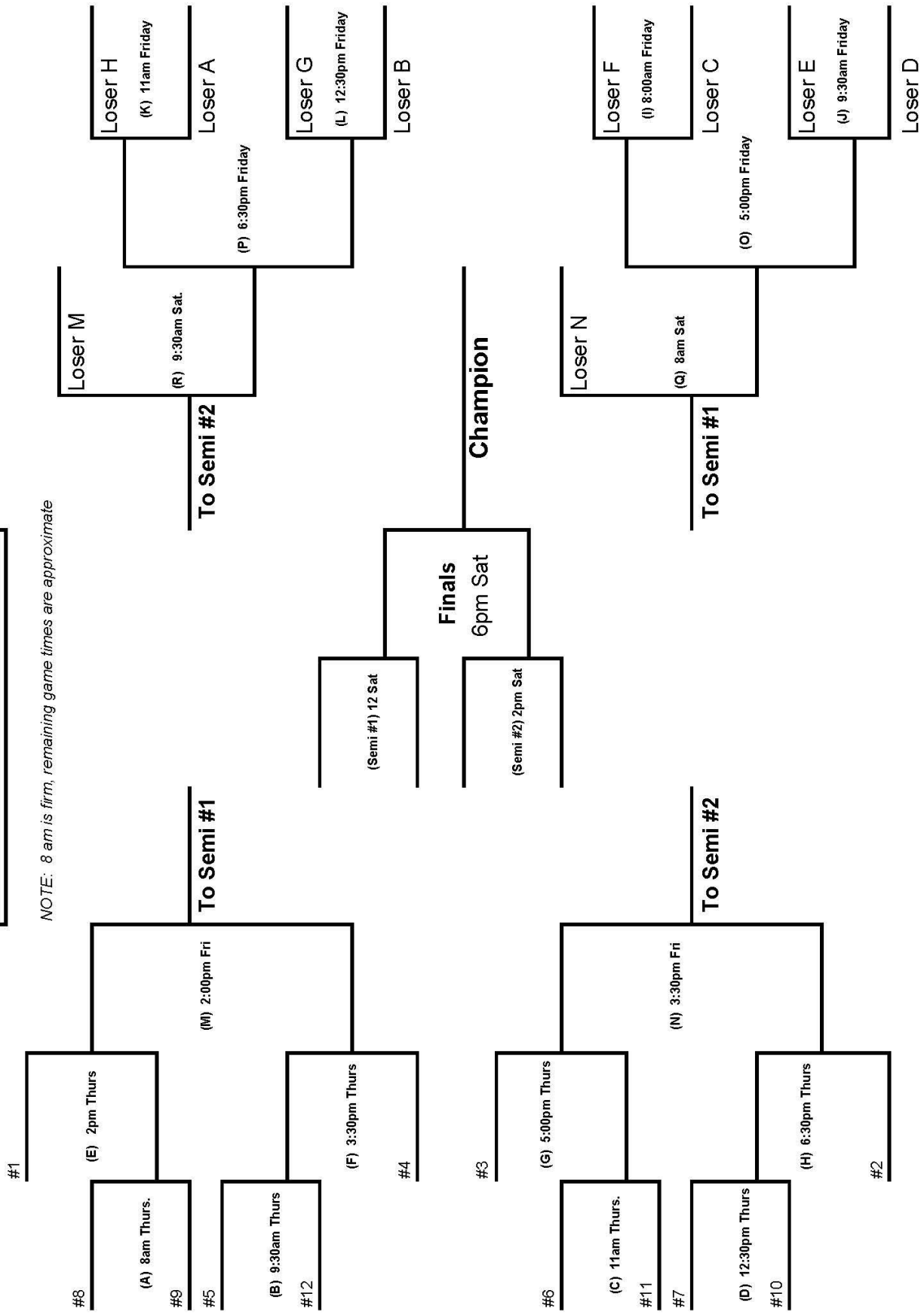

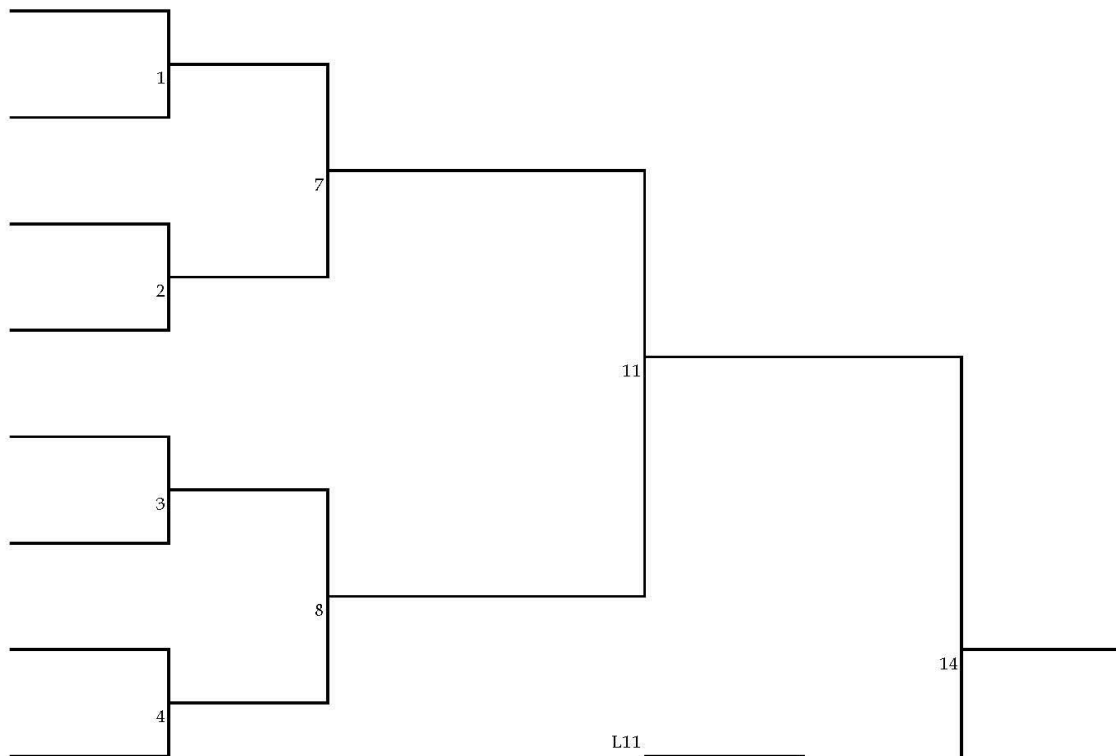
CHSAA State Volleyball Bracket

Contender's Bracket

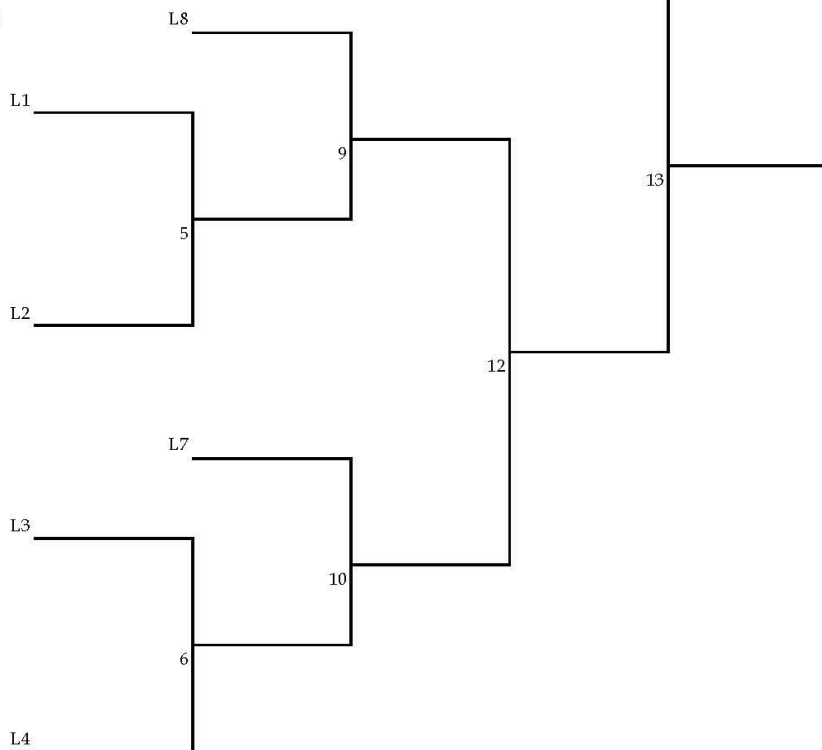


Boys Volleyball - 8 Team Double Elimination
