Team Entrance: Teams may enter 75 minutes before the first game

- Next 3 games, teams may enter 90 minutes before their game

Buses: Buses can park in the main parking lot in the school drop-off area.

Parking: Team/Game Officials Entrance will be at the door furthest to the north on the west side.

Team Dressing: Locker Rooms will be marked with team names.

- White Boards – please bring your own portable one for locker room
- Gatorade Jugs/Water Bottles – bring your own, may be filled/refilled at the stadium

Warm-Up Time: A mandatory 30-minute warm-up on the game field will be allowed for each game.

8:15am – Teams may warm on the match field (begin 30 minutes on match clock)

8:45 – Teams line up in the entry/exit way of the locker room area

8:47 – Teams march to middle of field

8:49 – Introduction of the visiting team's players and coaching staff

8:53 – Introduction of the home team's players and coaching staff

8:57 – Introduction of the match officials

8:59 – Playing of the National Anthem

9:00am – Start the match

Similar start for warm-ups to other game times

- 11:15 am for 12:00 pm game
- 2:15 pm for 3:00 pm game
- 5:15 pm for 6:00 pm game

Team Benches: West side of field (Home on north, Visitor on south)

- Highest seeded team on each bracket is the Home team
- Bench area for players, coaches, manager(s) and trainer only

Gatelist: Gatelist should have a maximum of 32 people; no more than 25 players, 7 coaches/managers.

- Official team videographer – if your team has one, it must be accounted for as one of your 7 coaches/managers on your gatelist (no team photographers)

Ball Runners: Each school needs to bring at least two ball runners. Please send these names to Colette. They should enter the team/officials entrance on the west side. They are not counted towards your 32 maximum gatelist.

Administrators: Need a maximum of 5 admin per school to help with crowd control (send names to Colette). Check in at the entrance on the west side of stadium closer to south end (with Mary Helen).

- Receive field passes at entrance – to be used for admin ONLY (not photographers, etc.)
- Coaches allowed 5 additional spectators (total not per coach) in the stands for family. Send Colette their names. They will check in at the west entrance (closer to south end).

National Anthem: If you have a student interested in singing the National Anthem, let Justin and/or Colette know.

Spectator Entrance & Seating: Must enter through Northeast entrance. This is the only entry for fans. Seating will all be on West side of stadium (behind your team benches) and clearly marked. Overflow seating will be open on East side of stadium

- Switchbacks has a **clear bag policy** and will check bags (fans only) when entering the stadium. Please view the [Weidner Field Information](#) page before arrival.

Officials: Game officials enter through Team/Game Officials entrance on northwest side of stadium.

Livestreaming: NFHS Network will livestream all championship games. Do NOT enter your game on NFHS Network. No schools allowed to livestream. Link to NFHS Network: [Live Stream CHSAA Sports | NFHS Network](#)

Media Check-in: All Media will need to check-in with their CHSAA 2023-2024 Media pass. This pass must be visible at all times. Per CHSAA policy, **no official team photographers** will be credentialed.

- All Media will check-in and enter through the West entrance (closer to south side). This includes student media who must have their 2023-2024 CHSAA student media pass.

Trainer: CHSAA will provide a trainer for Championship games. If your athletes need to be taped schools will need to provide the materials (i.e. tape). It is not the responsibility of the CHSAA trainers to provide materials for all athletes.

Inclement Weather: The CHSAA Assistant Commissioner along with the facility liaison will determine if the match field is in good enough condition and playable.

- Matches suspended due to inclement weather – any suspended game will be restarted from the point of interruption and carried to its completion. The score, time and ball possession will roll over to the restarted game.

- **Review your expectations with your students**
- **No noisemakers, this includes vuvuzela's**
- **School administrators to handle the issues of the cheers and taunts immediately**
- **Do not rush the field**
