1:20 PM – #8 Ralston Valley (Away) vs. #1 Northfield (Home)

3:40 PM – #5 Denver East (Away) vs. #4 Cherry Creek (Home)

6:00 PM – #23 Fort Collins (Away) vs. #2 Boulder (Home)

*As a precaution, please bring both home and away uniforms.

Team Entrance: Teams can be dropped off on the East side of the stadium - 1499 S Race St (S. Race St. & E. Florida Ave.). Teams will enter the East entrance beginning at 9:30 a.m. for the first game. We ask that teams try and enter all together if possible. See attached map for more detail.

Buses: Buses should drop off teams at East entrance and park in that lot. Teams driving themselves may also park in the East parking lot.

Team Dressing: Locker rooms are available; teams will be directed upon entry at the stadium. Teams will need to remove their belongings at halftime and place them behind their benches.

Warm-Up Time: A mandatory 30-minute warm-up on the game field will be allowed for each game. Teams may warm-up on adjacent practice field (west of stadium) prior to official warm-up (if available).

10:15am Warm-up begin.

10:45 Teams line up for introductions.

10:47 Introduce the visiting team's players and coaches.

10:52 Introduce the home team's players and coaches.

10:57 Introduce the officials.

10:59 Play the National Anthem.

11:00am Start 1st Quarterfinal game.

Similar start for warm-up to other game times:

- 12:35 am for 1:20 pm game

- 2:55 pm for 3:40 pm game

- 5:15 pm for 6:00 pm game

Team Benches: East side of the field (opposite the stands). Home bench on South end, Visitors on North end.

Gatelist & Bench Area: Maximum on the Gatelist and in the Bench Area is 32; this includes maximum 25 players and up to 7 essential personnel - coaches/managers. Teams are also allowed a trainer in addition to their 7 essential personnel. No parents, spectators or non-school officials may be present on the track, sideline, or in the vicinity of the playing field.

Ball Runners: Each school must have at least two ball runners (maximum of four). Please get names to Colette ASAP to put on your gatelist.

Admin: Each school may list up to 5 additional names on their gatelist to help with crowd control. Please get these names to Colette to add to your gatelist.

National Anthem: If you have a student interested in singing the National Anthem, let Justin and/or Colette know.

Fan Parking, Entry & Seating: Fans should park on the West side of the stadium. Additional parking is on the east side of the stadium and the Denver South school parking lot to the north.

All fans must enter on the west side of the stadium. Fan entrance will open at 10:00 am. No entrance on the east side - teams only. See map for additional parking & seating information.

Bag policy: Bags are discouraged but any brought into the stadium are subject to be searched. Coolers are prohibited unless brought by the team (trainer included) for the sideline.

No Re-Entry Policy: All City Stadium has a no re-entry policy during the course of the game. Ticketed guests who exit are NOT permitted to re-enter with a previously scanned ticket.

CHSSA Quarterfinals Ticket Prices:

Adults- \$8.00, Students K-12 and Seniors 60+ - \$5.00 (Not including fees)

- **MOBILE TICKETS ONLY** (no cash sales at venue). Please tell your fans to purchase ahead of time. Fan entrances will open 1 hour before the first game (10:00 am).

Passes: 2024-25 CHSAA Accepted Passes that will be honored includes digital courtesy cards, CHSCA coaches cards, CHSAA media passes and CHSAA officials passes.

Concession Stands: West side of the stadium.

Officials: Game officials should park and enter on the west side of the stadium (main entrance). CHSAA/school personnel will direct them to their dressing room.

Livestreaming: CHSAA guidelines are followed. No livestreaming allowed as the NFHS Network will be covering the 5A quarterfinal games. Livestream link: <https://www.nfhsnetwork.com/associations/chsaa>.

Media Check-in: All Media will need to check-in with their CHSAA 2024-2025 Media pass. This pass must be visible at all times. Per CHSAA policy, **anyone on the field must be CHSAA media credentialed.**

- Media may check-in at the main or team entrance. This includes student media who must have their 2024-2025 pass to check-in and wear at all times.

Game Video: Each school is responsible for their own video and may video from the bleachers or press box if room is available.

Trainer: CHSAA will provide a trainer for the 5A quarterfinals. All City Stadium has a training room with ice available. If your athletes need to be taped, schools will need to provide the materials (i.e. tape). It is not the responsibility of the CHSAA trainers to provide materials for all athletes.

Tobacco Free: The use of tobacco by students, teachers, staff and visitors in or on any school property or at any student activity sponsored by the school district is prohibited.
