SCRATCHES

The deadline to scratch athletes and have those spots be filled by the next athlete in the rankings is 11:59 PM **TONIGHT 5/12**. To officially scratch an athlete, you MUST email Jenn Roberts-Uhlig (jrobertsuhlig@chsaa.org) with the following information:

- Athlete Name
- Event
- School
- Classification

PACKETS

Team packets are available once doors open (7:00 am Thursday, 7:15am Friday & Saturday) and throughout the day of competition. Only coach or school designee can sign for team packet.

COACHES

Coach passes & wristbands MUST be worn at all times

IMPLEMENT WEIGH INS

Weigh-in's for implements begin 1 hour prior to assigned check in.

SPIKES

3/16-inch spikes or shorter will be the ONLY allowed spike length on track & runways. These will be checked by the head official prior to the race/event. The meet referee/games committee has the authority to disqualify any contestant who does not meet these requirements. Runner's Roost will have spikes for sale at the state meet.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

A. Electronic devices may not be used by coaches or competitors in restricted areas. Refer to rule 4-6-6.

B. Earbuds/headphones shall not be used in competition areas by athletes, this includes all field event venues as well as at the start and finish line on the track. This is a safety concern in all of these areas. Competitors wearing ear buds may not be aware of verbal warnings of an approaching athlete on a runway, a stray throwing implement, or someone running full speed in a lane on the track. Coaches and officials will make this clear to all competitors and if competitors do not heed this warning, they shall be disqualified.

HIGH JUMP RUNWAY MARKERS

Not more than two markers may be placed on the high jump runway. Markers cannot be located within 2 meters (6ft 6in) of either upright.

STARTING HEIGHTS FOR VERTICAL JUMPS - 1A, 2A, 3A, 4A, 5A BOYS & GIRLS

High Jump

Start Height determined by beginning from the next whole inch above the current state meet record and working down in 2" increments to a starting height of at least 2" below the last qualifying height in 2A-3A-4A-5A and at least 4"; below the last qualifying height in 1A.

Increments will be 2" increments until there are three (3) jumpers left, then 1" increments in all classifications.

Pole Vault

Start Height determined by beginning from the next whole inch above the current state meet record and working down in 6" increments to a starting height of at least 6" below the last qualifying height in 2A-3A-4A-5A and at least 12"; below the last qualifying height in 1A.

Increments will be 6" increments until there are three (3) jumpers left, then 3" increments in all classifications.

PARKING

\$10 Parking Fee per day. Security Staff will direct vehicles to designated lots on west and north side of stadium. Handicap parking will be located east of stadium. Vehicles parked in non-designated areas and without a parking pass will be ticketed and towed. Parking needs to be purchased through [GoFan](#). BUS PARKING

Limited parking on the frontage road. Once the spaces are full, buses will be directed to park at Trailblazer stadium which is a 5-minute walk from Jeffco stadium. (Bus drivers must have school issued ID and can enter at no charge at the competitor/coach northeast entrance).
