Individual Academic All-State

(Certificates: [First Team](#) | [Honorable Mention](#))

First Team Criteria: (school issued)

1-3.60 or higher cumulative GPA

2-minimum junior in school

3-must be a letter winner or equivalent in sport/activity nominated

4-must be a participant in a CHSAA sanctioned sport/activity during current season

(Note: Cumulative GPA's through the Fall Semester will be used for Winter & Spring. Cumulative GPA's through the Spring Semester will be used for Fall.) (Note: A student may be named in each activity season.)

Honorable Mention: (school issued)

1-3.30 to 3.59 cumulative GPA

2-minimum junior academic standing

3-must be a letter winner or equivalent in sport/activity nominated

4-must be a participant in a CHSAA-sponsored sport/activity during current season

(Note: Cumulative GPA's through the Fall Semester will be used for Winter & Spring. Cumulative GPA's through the Spring Semester will be used for Fall.) (Note: A student may be named in each activity season.)

SCHEELS All-Star

This award program strives to recognize students from member schools who demonstrate the following attributes:

- a. Problem Solving
- b. Team Player
- c. Positive Attitude
- d. Honesty and Integrity
- e. Community Service
- f. Humility
- g. Striving for Excellence
- h. Working above and beyond to get the job done

Each CHSAA member school will nominate 1-male and 1-female senior student. The deadline for schools to nominate students is March 20. After this deadline, 5-male finalists and 5-female finalists will be selected by a panel of membership representatives, including athletic directors, coaches, and CHSAA staff. From this group of finalists, SCHEELS will select 1-male and 1-female all-star scholarship winner. Each winner (male & female) will be awarded a one-time \$2500 scholarship to be used for any post-secondary education (including trade schools). Scholarship award winners will be recognized on CHSAA and SCHEELS social media. Winners will be presented with their scholarship at the Legislative Council meeting (Date TBA).
