### School Packet Pick-Up

Packets may be picked up starting at **7:30 a.m.** on Saturday, November 1, on the second floor of the event center. You can pick up packets for all classifications.

### Team Check-In (Start Line)

Team check-in will start at 8:00 am for all classifications. Coach and team must report together. Team uniforms will be checked and running members will receive a wristband if their uniform is in compliance. Team would then be free to complete their regular warm-up.

### Legal Uniforms

- Please note that the warning for a non-compliant uniform will be given to each athlete at the time of initial check-in. All athletes with a compliant uniform will be given a wristband.
- An athlete with a non-compliant uniform will receive a warning. All athletes with a noncompliant uniform will not be given a wristband. He/she will be told to make the uniform right. If they return and have not changed or altered the uniform, they will then be disqualified. If the uniform has been made compliant, the athlete will then receive a wristband.

Sunglasses may be worn by competitors.

Hats may be worn by competitors. They must be recognized athletic wear (no floppy hats or distracting ornamentation), must be used as intended (baseball caps with brims facing forward for sun-blocking).

Gloves may be worn by competitors.

Hair devices, hard or soft, may be worn to control hair. (headbands, hair clips, bobby pins, ribbons, barrettes, etc). Decorative hair bows with no dimension greater than 3 inches may be worn in the hair.

Head coverings worn for religious reasons are not considered hair devices and must not be made of abrasive, hard or unyielding materials and fit securely or be fastened to the body and/or uniform to remain in a fixed position.

### Parking

All vehicles will be charged **\$20**. Spectators can only access the route to the NPEC parking lots from the 21st Street & West Rio Grande Street or 8th Street & Lower Gold Camp Road intersections. They will be turned away if they try to enter at the "BUS ENTRANCE" at the top of the 8th Street Hill. Only school vehicles (bus, school logo van, or suburban) will be allowed in at no cost. **School vehicles and buses should enter the venue on the frontage road on 8<sup>th</sup> street** - south of the facility (Please see the map by [clicking here](#)).

CHSAA activity passes do not work for parking.

The indoor barn area onsite will be available for team camps.

### Finishing Results

The official order of finish for runners at the state meet will be determined using a bib transponder and Finish Lynx cameras.

### Inhalers

If a runner is in need of an inhaler during their race please provide doctors note at check in or contact the CHSAA office prior to meet. NOTE: Any other accommodations please reach out to the CHSAA office prior to the meet.

### Awards Presentation

All individual awards will be presented after each race and all team awards will be presented following the last race of their classification inside the arena. Must be in school/team uniform/warm ups ONLY to be on podium.

## T-Shirts/Souvenirs

Official 2025 CHSAA State Cross Country Meet T-shirts with four-color logo will be available at the state meet while they last. Apparel and souvenirs will also be available for purchase on Friday at Norris Penrose during the state meet walk through time (3:30 pm – 5:30 pm).

## Course Walk Through

No teams or individuals will be allowed on the State Cross Country Course the week of state. This includes Norris Penrose and Bear Creek. Due to the course being prepared for the state meet, this will eliminate confusion on where you are allowed to be. The **ONLY** time schools/team will be allowed on the state cross country course for a walk/run through will be on the Friday prior to the state meet from 3:30 pm and conclude by 5:30 pm.

Only participating athletes and their coaches may participate in the course walk through. **No team or individuals will be allowed to warm up at the start line or enter the stadium arena toward the finish during the walk/run through.** **ALL ATHLETES MUST STAY OFF THE START LINE AND OUT OF FINISH AREA.** Coaches must supervise their athletes. No wheels, and no marking of the course will be allowed. Not abiding by these expectations could result in a disqualification from the meet.
