



# 2025 CHSAA STATE GYMNASTICS INFORMATION

Please see the attached copy of the 2025 4A and 5A State Gymnastics Rotation Schedule. The individual and team qualifiers were determined today by members of the committee based on the following directions determined by the CHSAA Gymnastics Advisory Committee and adopted by the Legislative Council:

## **4A/5A STATE ROTATIONS**

When teams and individual groups are placed in the state rotation they will be placed by the below order:  
Top 4 Teams: Rotations 9-12; Next 4 Teams; Rotations 5-8; Individuals & remaining teams: Rotations 1-4.

## **4A TEAM QUALIFYING**

Nine (9) teams will qualify to compete at the state championships. The top team score in each regional plus the next six (6) best team scores regardless of regional shall qualify for state.

## **4A INDIVIDUAL QUALIFYING**

The top three (3) individuals in each event from each regional, not on a state qualifying team plus the top nine (9) individuals on each event regardless of regional (not on a state qualifying team) will qualify for the state tournament (3 groups of 6 individuals per event – 18 total)

## **5A TEAM QUALIFYING**

Ten (10) teams will qualify to compete at the state championships. The top team score in each regional plus the next (7) best team scores regardless of regional shall qualify for state.

## **5A INDIVIDUAL QUALIFYING**

The top two (2) individuals on each event from each regional, not on a state qualifying team plus the top six (6) individuals on each event regardless of regional (not on a state qualifying team) will qualify for the state tournament (2 groups of 6 Individuals per event – 12 total).

## **IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR STATE**

### **4A STATE MEET**

Friday afternoon competition begins at **1:10 pm**. with the top nine (9) teams and three (3) groups of individuals competing for team honors, all-around championships and for the top 15 spots to qualify for individual finals. This is to be done in a 12-team rotation, four events at a time. Finals will feature all events at one time starting at 12:30 p.m. on Saturday.

### **5A STATE MEET**

Thursday afternoon competition begins at **1:10 pm** with the top ten (10) teams and two (2) groups of individuals competing for team honors, all-around championships, and for the top 15 spots to qualify for individual finals. This is to be done in a 12-team rotation, four events at a time. Finals will feature all events at one time starting at 12:30 p.m. on Saturday.

### **STATE ATHLETIC TRAINER**

The CHSAA provides an Athletic Trainer at all state events, however it is the responsibility of the team/athlete to provide their own tape and supplies for pre-meet taping.

### **INDIVIDUAL FINALISTS**

Individual finalists for Saturday's finals must wear team-approved, team-colored leotard for competition. No club or third-party leotards allowed.

## **ALTERNATES AT STATE**

Alternates for final competition are required to warm-up in case of injury to any of the top 15 finalists.

## **DOORS FOR SPECTATORS**

Doors to the building will open at **12:00 pm** on Thursday and Friday and **11:00 am** on Saturday. Access to the building will not be granted before then, please plan ahead.

## **MUSIC**

Individual CD's or iPod's will be required for each floor exercise competitor. It is advisable for coaches to prepare a master copy and have it available at the meet. CD and iPod players will be available.

## **WARM-UPS**

No warm-up is allowed on the competition floor during competition.

## **EQUIPMENT**

**Competition beam will be the non-reflex beam, and the practice beam will be the reflex beam**

## **COACHES MEETING**

Fifteen minutes is allotted for a coaches meeting at 11:45. **Gymnasts will not be allowed on the floor at this time.**

**The VEAP (Venue Emergency Action Plan) will be covered in this meeting as well.**

## **COMPETITOR CARDS**

The CHSAA will provide color-coded cards for each individual event:

The competitor cards (4 per school) will be supplied by the CHSAA at site registration. Four cards will be completed for the preliminary session. The scoring table will complete the cards for finals.

## **AWARDS**

Winners at the State Championships will receive medals for the first eight places in individuals and all-around events, and a trophy will be presented to the first-place team and the second-place team. All team scores will be announced. Any school represented at the state meet may qualify for team awards. Awards will be presented at the closing ceremonies.

**When gymnasts are accepting awards during all regional meets and state meets it will be mandatory to wear school issued competition attire that gymnast competed the meet in. This includes accepting a team earned trophy.**

## **STUDENT MEDIA**

The 2025-2026 **ORANGE** Student Media Pass is the only student media pass that will be accepted at post season and championship CHSAA events. It is the expectation of the CHSAA that all student media follow the guidelines outlined in the Student Media Bulletin and sign in at the appropriate entrance when arriving at events. The pass must be clearly visible and worn at all times.

NOTE: The Student Media Pass is to be used by students only.

**Student Media Entrance:** Main entrance.

### **Gymnastics Media Restrictions and Reminders**

Always give the competitors a minimum of 10 feet from each apparatus and mat. Judges sight lines may not be broached, and no flash photography is allowed.

## **BALLOONS**

No Balloons will be permitted at the State Championship Site. Please share this information with your spectators and parents.

## **SCHOOL BANNERS**

Only official school banners of non-paper material will be permitted. Only Banners with school name and official school's logo (by board adoption) will be allowed.

All tickets will be sold online via [GoFan](#). No tickets will be sold onsite, and no cash will be accepted.

## PURCHASE TICKETS

There is a small convenience fee and any credit card charge that comes with ordering your ticket(s) on-line. The GoFan ticketing system has a touch and go validation process. **The consumer will need to have a mobile device available to show at the ticket line to redeem tickets and gain entrance into the event.**

## COACH/ATHLETE ADMITTANCE POLICIES FOR STATE

The roster on the CHSAA platform will be used for check in at the state championships.

Please be aware that only 12 gymnasts, 3 coaches and 1 manager will be let into the state gymnastics meet FREE of charge. All additional gymnasts/coaches/managers who check in using this gatelist, your school will be sent an invoice by the CHSAA office.

ALL athletes **WILL** receive an athlete pass this year and athletes' hands will be stamped when checking in. Additional team members over 12 will be allowed in for **\$10.00** each (for coach and athlete). Schools will be invoiced if a ticket is not purchased through GoFan. GoFan tickets for additional team members will be redeemed when the team checks-in, so please present these tickets to the event staff. Additional admittance may be purchased for Thursday or Friday. Additional admittance cannot be purchased on Saturday.

This same gate list will be used to admit athletes for finals. Hands will be stamped again and passes will need to be presented.
